

League of Women Voters of Chicago Rules for the 2020 Annual Meeting

Admission: Admission to the Annual Meeting shall be limited to those members and guests, who preregistered.

Amendments: All motions to amend must be written in chat preceded by the word motion. Motion to amend: ...

Announcements: All oral announcements shall be made by Board members. Any member who wishes to speak shall hit "raise hand" and await recognition by the chair and state clearly her/his name. (See graphic below)

Call the Question: Unless there has been an opportunity for two speakers **pro** (for) and two speakers **con** (against) a motion to make their positions known, the Question may not be called. In chat type Call the Question.

Directions to the Board: Any directions to the Board shall be typed in chat preceded by Direction:

Minutes: The minutes of the Annual Meeting shall be referred to a committee of three members appointed by the President to be read, corrected and approved. This committee shall act upon the minutes within one month from the close of the Annual Meeting.

Motions: All motions not originating in a committee shall be typed in chat preceded by the word Motion. This includes nominations made from the floor.

Nominations from the floor: All nominations from the floor must be seconded. The nominator then may have two minutes to speak to her/his nomination, and the seconder may also have two minutes.

Privilege of the Floor: Only members have the privilege of the floor during the business meeting unless permission is granted by the members. No person may speak twice until all who wish to speak to the same question have had an opportunity to speak. Speaking time shall be limited to two minutes for each speaker.

Resolutions: There shall be no resolutions, except those of a courtesy nature, presented or adopted by the Annual Meeting.

Seconds: Type Second in chat.

Voting: Only members may vote. Nonverbal voting will be accomplished by clicking on yes or no under Participants. (See graphic below)
