On December 7, 2021, there will be a Debt Exclusion vote to authorize the Town to invest in the construction of two new elementary schools. These two projects will replace three aging school buildings, and come to the voters after nearly 10 years of study and planning.

The League of Women Voters of Wellesley supports a <u>YES</u> vote on December 7th because a multitude of conditions at both schools have long hindered the ability to educate students in safe and appropriate facilities. It is time to address these deficiencies and ensure that these buildings meet modern structural and educational standards.

Join us to learn about these projects. After a presentation by School Committee members Catherine Mirick and Melissa Martin, there will be ample time for Q&A. Learn the facts, such as project costs, anticipated state reimbursement, tax impact, and more!
