SB361

Health insurance; coverage for contraceptive drugs and devices.

The League of Women Voters of Virginia supports SB 361. Contraception is an integral part of comprehensive health care. We believe that contraceptives should be accessible to all. Eliminating burdensome co-pays, cost-sharing, reimbursement requirements, and coverage delays would help decrease barriers to utilization of contraception thus increasing reproductive health equity in Virginia. Accessible contraception is critical for a range of reasons including and beyond preventing pregnancy. This essential care includes treating a range of healthcare needs such as hormonal regulation, endometriosis, uterine fibroids, and ovarian cysts, just to name a few.
