Guest Speaker: Tammy Kim, Vice Mayor City of Irvine Thursday, May 13, 2021 at 10:00 am

Tammy Kim was elected to Irvine City Council in November 2020, receiving the highest vote count for any City Council candidate in the city's history. Tammy is a mother, a nonprofit leader, educator, community advocate, small business owner and former corporate executive.

Born in Korea, Tammy's family immigrated to America when she was an infant. Raised in Flint, MI, her mother was a seamstress, and her father was a day laborer who saved up to start a small business, eventually moving to Baltimore, MD. As the first in her family to go to college, Tammy went on to a successful career as a business executive in Fortune 500 and venture backed technology start-ups, resolving highly complex business, management, and legal issues.

Tammy founded the Irvine based non-profit Korean American Center as a way to build bridges between intergenerational Korean Americans and the greater community and served as Managing Director. It then merged with Korean Community Services, becoming the largest social service provider serving the 110,000 Korean Americans in Orange County. Tammy also served as Chair of the Language Access Committee for the Orange County Registrar of Voters and a member of the City of Irvine Complete Count Committee for the 2020 Census.
