

Volunteer Position: Video Production Assistant

Purpose:

To create short broadcast videos and public service announcements to increase voter registration and turnout in Fresno County elections.

Primary Position Duties:

- 1. Assist LWVF producers with script development, videography, video editing, and post production for short TV programs and public service announcements.
- 2. May be assigned other related duties.

Time Commitment:

Minimum of 2 hours per week for academic year. Hours TBD by volunteer and LWVF production supervisor.

Benefits:

- 1. Develop relationships with others in LWVF, the Fresno video community, the Fresno County Registrar of Voters' office, and Fresno state students and alumni involved in community media.
- 2. Receive copies of videos you help create for your future portfolio use.
- 3. Gain video production skills and experience

Note: Volunteer may be eligible to take video production classes as part of LWVF membership in Community Media Access Collaborative for Fresno and Clovis (CMAC).
