# Committee on Little Rock Governance:

Kathleen Oleson and I have been observing this committee charged with studying Little Rock's governance and recommending possible changes. Carol Young, Kathleen and I also attended some of the public meetings the committee held seeking citizen input.

Accessible, accountable, responsible, responsive, equitable, effective, and balanced are values the governance study group believes should guide its recommendations on the best form of government for Little Rock.

The following are governmental issues the study group is looking at:

Mayor's general appointive powers

Mayor's power to hire/fire city manager and city attorney

Mayor's veto and/or line-item veto power

Minimum threshold for board to override a veto

Minimum voting percentage for elections of city board and mayor

Number of total wards/directors

Types of ward structure (at-large, regional, or ward only)

The Little Rock Governance Study Group plans to make its report to the City Board in early to mid -August. After it receives the Study Group report, the Board will decide what action to take on its recommendations.

Note: Mayor Stodola did not utilized all powers given to the Mayor by the special election of August 14, 2007. Mayor Scott has fully exercised mayoral powers given by the 2007 law since his assumption of office January 1, 2019.
